

Paradise of the North

We start our adventure through the most significant historical site on the island, the **Cabrits National Park**. A sight that history aficionados simply must see. Beautiful views of Portsmouth Harbor, Prince Rupert Bay, the Saints' Islands, and Guadeloupe. It is possible to envision historical ships going toward combat. The visitor can find intriguing information on the history of Fort Shirley, the wars fought, and the residents through signs and panels located throughout the site.

Our trip continues to the Morne Aux Diable volcano, or as we call it, **The Cold Sulphur Springs**, where visitors may experience the island's only "cold" spring—bubbling sulfur springs—by taking a short, simple climb into the volcanic core, which takes about 15 minutes. We drive down the picturesque but untamed Northeast coast and get the opportunity to visit and view locations where the Pirates of the Caribbean was filmed.

The Syndicate Nature Trail & Milton Falls, which is a spectacular hiking experience that highlights Dominica's remarkable natural beauty and unique species, is situated in the island's lush jungle. Hikers can see a variety of wildlife that lives in the jungle along the route, including the endemic Sisserou parrot and other bird species. The Milton Falls, located in the lush surroundings of Dominica, is a stunning natural attraction that captivates visitors with its beauty and tranquility. Nestled within the unspoiled rainforests of the island, this waterfall is renowned for its crystal-clear waters cascading down rocky cliffs into a serene pool below.



Paradise of the North


The stunning 60-acre Dominican paradise known as **Paradise Valley** is situated close to Portsmouth. The area features carefully chosen gardens and landscapes that feature both local and exotic flora, showcasing Dominica's natural beauty.

On Dominica's northeastern coast, in the community of Bense, sits the lovely natural swimming hole known as **Chaudiere Pool**. The Hampstead River feeds this tranquil lake, which is cut out of gray rock and is encircled by lush tropical foliage. It's the ideal spot to unwind and take in the scenery because of the pristine waters and serene surroundings.


Going further on Dominica's northeastern shore, close to the settlement of Calibishie, is a breathtaking natural landmark known as **Red Rocks**. It is a fantastic place to explore, have a picnic, or just take in the spectacular surroundings. It also offers stunning views of the Atlantic Ocean.

The Pointe Baptiste Estate **Chocolate Factory** is one of Dominica's most renowned chocolate companies. This family-run company, which is close to Calibishie, is well-known for its premium chocolate produced using cocoa that is sourced locally and its sustainable business methods. Dark chocolate, ginger, coffee, spice, hot pepper, lemongrass, tangerine, mint, and milk chocolate are among the chocolate bars they sell.

East Coast Treasure

One of Dominica's most magnificent waterfalls, **Jacko Falls** is renowned for its magnificent height, exquisite beauty, and serene surroundings. A beautiful five- to ten-minute trek through a thick tropical rainforest is enjoyed by the visitors. There will be a delightful mist in the air and the sound of flowing water to welcome you as you approach.

Spanny Falls is a stunning and easily reachable waterfall. It provides a tranquil getaway into nature, tucked away between the villages of Belles and Pond Casse. A family-friendly, somewhat quick hike that takes around 15 minutes from the trailhead. All visitors of all ages can enjoy the generally level and well-marked track. The sight of the waterfall plunging into a pristine, welcoming pool will welcome you.

Situated amid the verdant Morne Trois Pitons National Park, **Emerald Pool** is one of Dominica's most captivating natural landmarks. It's a 20-minute climb to Emerald Pool, where you'll be surrounded by colorful tropical plants and the sounds of the natural world while you stroll. The rich foliage reflecting in the crystal-clear water gives the pool its remarkable emerald-green color, hence its name.

The Carib Cultural Village, also called Kalinago Barana Autê, is an authentically restored traditional village that provides a rare window into the daily lives, history, and culture of the Indigenous Kalinago people who occupy the island. Traditional huts and structures where cultural activities and performances, crafts including canoe building, baking cassava, and basket weaving are on display for visitors to observe can be found at the Barana Aute. The village is a real community where the Kalinago people continue to celebrate and preserve their culture, not merely a tourist destination.

Southern Escape

One of Dominica's most famous natural landmarks, these twin waterfalls, which the locals refer to as "Mother" and "Father." Trafalgar Falls is situated in the Morne Trois Pitons National Park. The breathtaking natural location of Trafalgar Falls is ideal for trekking, photography, and taking in the tranquil splendor of Dominica's rainforest.

Titou Gorge is a breathtaking natural landmark renowned for its distinctive geological features and cool waters. The gorge is a tiny canyon created by cooling lava, and its name means "little holeThe light coming through the above canopy enhances the experience as the swim leads to a stunning cascade.

One of Dominica's most breathtaking natural landmarks is Middleham Falls. This waterfall is the highest on the island and is situated in the Morne Trois Pitons National Park. The moderately difficult journey to Middleham Falls has multiple rises and descents through a gorgeous jungle. You will be rewarded with a stunning vista and a lovely swimming hole at the base of the falls once you arrive.



Southern Escape

The largest of Dominica's four lakes, **Freshwater Lake** is situated at an altitude of roughly 760 meters (2,500 feet) above sea level. This stunning location is renowned for its glistening blue and green hues. The lake is surrounded by a 2.5-mile route that offers fantastic hiking options

The capital city of Roseau is home to the stunning and ancient Dominica **Botanic Gardens**. The 40-acre gardens were first created in 1890 with the intention of preserving supplies of island-grown crops. It has developed over time into a verdant preserve with a wide range of tropical trees, shrubs, and flowers that draw a variety of vibrant bird species.

Dominica is well known for its natural **Hot Sulphur Springs/Spas** which provide a special fusion of leisure and scenic beauty, mineral-rich volcanic water in pools of different temperatures. It is the ideal location for rest and renewal because of the natural environment of the tropical gardens and the healing qualities of the sulfur springs.

Extreme adventure

Situated in Morne Trois Pitons National Park, Dominica's Boiling Lake is an intriguing natural phenomenon. Here are some important facts regarding it. A flooded fumarole is a volcanic vent that is filled with bubbling water that has a greyish-blue color. A mist of vapor typically envelops the lake, giving it a surreal look. The world's second-largest hot lake is this one. It takes roughly three to four hours to hike through the Valley of Desolation to get to the **Boiling Lake**.

One of Dominica's most beautiful waterfalls, **Sari Falls**, is situated on the east coast of the island, and the path is regarded as somewhat difficult. It entails traversing rugged terrain and repeatedly crossing the Sari Sari River. The waterfall itself is breathtaking, tumbling into a cool pool at the foot of a sheer cliff. After the hike, take a refreshing plunge in the swimmable pool at the base of the falls.

Victoria Falls, located on the island of Dominica, is a stunning waterfall that offers a unique and adventurous experience for visitors. Known locally as "Victoria Falls," it is situated in the village of Delices on the island's southeastern coast. The trail requires traversing rocky paths, crossing rivers, and climbing over boulders, thus making this a difficult trek.













